Also at Yezerksi, Oscar Palacio haunts cities such as Boston and Lawrence with his camera, finding small, beautiful passages amid the brick and concrete. Who would think that something titled "Concrete Wall" could have so many textures? Framed in green-painted steel adorned with a flower motif, the concrete comes spackled on, but also in great rounds, as if trying to mimic a stone wall. Outside the steel, it's dappled with white paint. Even the cobblestone street at its base seems an intentional part of this assemblage.

Palacio's lush color prints imbue these unexpected corners with a grandeur that they never expected, but perhaps secretly aspired to.
